

References to Jesus Raising from the Dead

egeiro: To awaken, to wake up, arouse, cause to rise up from sleep; to arouse from the sleep of death, to call the dead to life.

(The energy to “raise” comes from OUTSIDE of the subject.)

1	Matthew 17:23	"And they shall kill him, and the third day he shall be raised again. "
2	Matthew 27:63	"Saying, Sir, we remember that that deceiver said, while he was yet alive, After three days I will rise again.
3	Matthew 27:64	"Command therefore that the sepulchre be made sure until the third day, lest his disciples come by night, and steal him away, and say unto the people, He is risen from the dead."
4	Matthew 28:6	"He is not here: for he is risen , as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.
5	Matthew 28:7	"And go quickly, and tell his disciples that he is risen from the dead..."
6	Mark 16:6	"And they shall kill him, and the third day he shall be raised again. "
7	Mark 16:14	"Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen. "
8	Luke 24:6	"He is not here, but is risen. "
9	Luke 24:34	"The Lord is risen indeed..."

10	John 21:14	"This is now the third time that Jesus shewed himself to his disciples, after that he was risen from the dead.
11	Acts 3:15, 4:10, 5:30, 10:40, 13:30, 13:37 References by Peter and Paul to God raising Jesus from the dead.	
12	Romans 6:4	"...like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life."
13	Romans 6:9	"Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him."
14	Romans 8:11	"But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you."
15	Romans 8:34	"It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again , who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us."
16	Romans 10:9	"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved."
17	1 Corinthians 6:14	"And God hath both raised up the Lord, and will also raise up (<i>exegeiro</i>) us by his own power.
		<i>exegeiro</i> - to rouse fully; to resuscitate from death; Used only 2X in NT, here and Romans 9:17

18	1 Corinthians 15	Used 18X regarding Christ and the dead being raised. The word <i>anisthemi</i> is not used in this section.
19	2 Timothy 2:8	"Remember that Jesus Christ of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel."

anisthemi: to cause to stand up or rise, to raise up from laying down, to stand up, to raise up from the dead.
The energy to "raise" comes from WITHIN the subject.

1	Mark 16:9	"Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene..."	
2	Luke 24:7	"The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again. "	
3	Luke 24:46	"Thus it is written, and thus it behooved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day."	
4	John 20:9 Disciples at the empty tomb	"For as yet they knew not the scripture, that he must rise again from the dead."	
4	Acts 2:24, 2:32, 3:26, 17:3, 17:31 References to God raising Jesus from the dead spoken by Peter and Paul.		
6	1Thessalonians 4:14	"If we believe that Jesus died and rose again ..."	Physically died, physically rose.
